Help for people living with memory loss and those who care for them

Care Coordination

Our Care Coordinators provide ongoing support in person or by phone to help you address challenges associated with memory loss.

- Understand more about conditions that affect the brain and memory, including Mild Cognitive Impairment, Alzheimer's Disease, and other dementias
- Discover tools and develop strategies to more effectively manage everyday tasks
- Identify and strengthen your formal and informal circles of support
- Think about and make plans to address potential future concerns
- Share your needs, worries, and desires with family and friends



Care Partners is proud to sponsor the **Cook County Memory Cafe**, a casual, once-a-month gathering for people experiencing memory loss and the family and friends who care for them. Most meetings feature simple activities or short presentations from community members and organizations.

Caregiver Support

Care Partners is here to support those on the journey of caregiving, while honoring their unique situations, strengths, and goals.

- Caregiver Coaches meet one-on-one to help you assess your needs and care for yourself while supporting a loved one with memory loss.
- Trained volunteers can provide safe, non-medical respite companionship to your loved one at home.
- A monthly Connecting Caregivers gathering creates safe space for rest, casual conversation, and mutual encouragement.
- Classes such as Powerful Tools for Caregivers feature effective, evidence-based curriculum from trusted sources

Community Engagement

We work to raise community awareness about dementia and memory loss through initiatives such as Dementia Friends and our support of the Grand Marais Walk to End Alzheimer's Disease.

We also encourage a broader conversation about issues related to aging by hosting gatherings such as our Lunch & Learn series, Reframe Aging Monthly Roundtable, Grief Support Group, and other community events and workshops.
